How to clean a window

Solutions

A number of different water-based solutions can be chosen depending on the window itself and the material that frames it. The most common solutions include: vinegar, non-sudsing ammonia, dishwashing liquids, and tri-sodium phosphate (TSP). Consult a local distributor to determine which product is right for your specific project.

Technique


As with most detailed work, consistently excellent window cleaning relies as much on a practiced technique as conscious attention. Key to quality results is applying the right amount of solution to keep the window wet until it is squeegeed dry. Alliance in Mfg. LLC a U.S.based manufacturers of professional

window cleaning tools, offers the following technique of "Cutting the Mountain" to remove solution efficiently without streaking.

Window cleaning is best done in the shade, on cloudy days, or early in the day before windows have heated up. Hot windows dry more quickly, often before they can be wiped dry with a squeegee. It is also much harder to go back and fix mistakes on a hot window.

If you have to clean hot windows, follow the following suggestions:

- 1) Use very clean water
- 2) Put extra soap in the water
- 3) Use a new squeegee blade
- 4) Use more water, more frequently
- Clean smaller sections of large windows
- Use minimal pressure with the squeegee.
